Important Coronavirus (COVID-19) update for MTA members

The Coronavirus (COVID-19) is having a big impact on businesses in South Australia.

While there have been no confirmed cases at the MTA, in the interests of preventing the spread of the Coronavirus we have suspended all MTA Zone and Divisional meetings and membership visits until **the end of April this year**.

The MTA will continue to operate with a few key differences until further notice:

- MTA staff will be phoning businesses (replacing face to face visits) to discuss how you are managing in the present environment and offering help wherever we can.
- MTA WR staff remain readily contactable to assist you with any issues you may face.
